- Thursday 16 March 2023 (National)

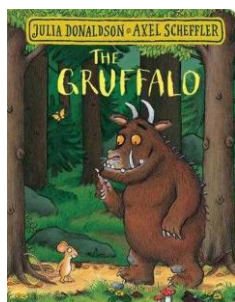
You will be informed as soon as possible should this decision change.
